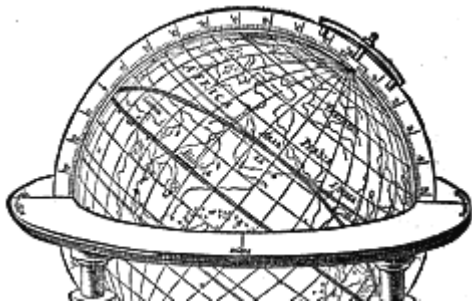


The New Web Library
